



BIOGRAPHY

Luna Waves – the brainchild of Bedford-based singer/songwriter/multi-instrumentalist Rob Muir – released its debut album on 27th July 2018.

The album is called Seafoam Dream (Part 1), named to reflect the theme of the record – specifically the mercurial nature of hopes and dreams – echoed in the lyrics throughout. The songs are laden with dark and dreamy guitars and synths, that shimmer and evoke the changing moods of the sky and the ocean.

The album was produced by Chris Corney (The Ravines, The Quireboys) at his studio in Shefford, Bedfordshire. The result is a record drenched in the sounds of the '80s and '90s, drawing from influences as diverse as indie-rock, folk-rock, shoegaze, dream-pop and psychedelia.

Recorded during an intense burst of creativity between December 2017 and May 2018, more than 30 songs were written for the project, which led to the decision to release the album in two parts.

Raised on Pearl Jam, Nirvana, Soundgarden and The Smashing Pumpkins, Rob considers himself a '90s kid at heart. However, he was exposed to a miscellany of influences – such as John Lennon and Jimi Hendrix – by his musician father, which have coloured and shaped the Luna Waves sound.

Further inspired by contemporary artists like The War On Drugs, Ben Howard, Kurt Vile, Ryan Adams, Gemma Hayes, Wild Nothing, Beach House, The Cure, Sunflower Bean, Amber Arcades and Tame Impala, Seafoam Dream (Part 1) traverses emotional and ethereal sad pop landscapes, all while wearing its heart on its sleeve.

Luna Waves immediately followed Seafoam Dream (Part 1) by starting work on the 2nd album 'Scores For Imaginary Places', a mix of spacey instrumental pieces and brand new material, all expanding on the Luna Waves cinematic sound. The album is expected early 2019.

Preceding the release of Scores For Imaginary Places, the psych-rock tinged single Ocean Warm will be released on Friday 9th November 2018.

Seafoam Dream (Part 2) will follow in 2019. Release date TBD.
